# THIS IS HOW THE NIMBUS SOLUTIONS SUITE WORKS

In the Nimbus Solutions Suite Nimbus AR®, Nimbus GV® and Nimbus ShApp® are applied in one integrated system.



## SAFE, FLEXIBLE, UNIQUE

The Nimbus Solutions Suite includes all services of Nimbus AG in one integrated System. All servers and data recordings as well as the SMS and email gateway are located in Switzerland and are subject to Swiss law.

**The company invites all registered shareholders to the AGM.**  
**1a** The documents will be sent by e-mail.  
**1b** The documents will be sent by post.

**2** The shareholder decides whether to reply online or by post.

**3a** Shareholders have access to the Nimbus ShApp® via their own personal profile. A username, password and transaction number are used for logging in, which guarantees maximum security.  
**3b** The shareholder return the completed reply form by post.

**4a** Ordering an admission card or distribution of proxy and instructions to an independent proxy is done electronically.  
**4b** The forms are scanned and replies are stored in the AGM system.

**5** The independent proxy submits the votes in accordance with the voting rights transferred to him/her (Art. 10 para. 1 VegüV [Ordinance against excessive remuneration])
